

AICLU 2024 PAVIA: HOW TO GET HERE

By train - Pavia is served by a train station located in the city center. The station is connected to Milan, Turin, Genoa, Venice, Rome, Naples and other Italian and European cities. Journey times vary by destination. Timetables on <http://www.trenitalia.it>. Most trains with final destination GENOA, VENTIMIGLIA, SESTRI LEVANTE, LA SPEZIA e VOGHERA will stop in Pavia.

By plane - The closest airports to Pavia are Milano Malpensa, Milano Linate and Bergamo Orio al Serio. From these airports you can reach Pavia by train, bus or taxi. The closest airports are Milano Linate (EasyJet and several major airlines), Milano Malpensa (EasyJet and several major airlines) and Bergamo Orio al Serio (Ryanair). — From Milan Linate airport to Pavia: Bus to Milan Central Station (Milano Stazione Centrale) (25 minutes; timetables here <https://www.milano-aeroporti.it/liniate-shuttle/index.html>) or taxi (15 minutes), then trains to Pavia (25-40 minutes; <https://www.trenitalia.com/>). — From Milano Malpensa airport to Pavia: Trains headed to Milan Central Station (about 55 minutes, timetables on Trenitalia webpage <https://www.trenitalia.com/>), then trains to Pavia (<https://www.trenitalia.com/>). Trains to Milano Bovisa (every 20 minutes, the journey is about 30 minutes), change in Bovisa station to train S13 to Pavia (55 minutes). <https://www.trenitalia.com/>. Bus to Milan Central Station (about one hour <https://www.omio.it/>) then train to Pavia (25-40 minutes; see below <https://www.trenitalia.com/>). — From Bergamo Orio al Serio airport to Pavia: Bus (about one hour; <https://www.terravision.eu/italiano/>) to Milan Central Station, then trains to Pavia (<https://www.trenitalia.com/>). You can also take the city bus to Bergamo train station, then take a train to Milan (about 40 minutes) and change in Milano Lambrate (about 20 minutes).

By bus - Pavia is served by several bus companies that offer connections with nearby towns and villages. The bus station is located in Viale Trieste, a few steps from the train station.

By car - Pavia is located about 35 km south of Milan. To reach the city by car from Milan, you must take the A7 motorway in the direction Genoa and exit at the toll Bereguardo-Pavia Nord. Pavia is also served south by the A21 motorway (Turin - Piacenza). The exit for Pavia is CASTEGGIO.
